PROJECT OVERVIEW

Originally opened in the early 1970s, Colony Square was the first mixed-use destination to rise in the Southeast. North American Properties (NAP) acquired the 1.1-million-square-foot development in 2015 and reimagined its formerly enclosed, inward-looking design into a vibrant, urban, open-air hub. The redevelopment doubled Colony Square's open space while also significantly increasing its leasable space through two new office buildings and expanded retail footprints. Known as "Midtown's Living and Dining Room," the revitalized property has become an economic development catalyst for the district, boasting 24 service-driven retail and dining concepts, Class A office, luxury residential, and a dine-in movie theater set atop an 11-stall food hall.

NAP has ownership in Colony Square and oversees management, retail leasing, and parking services.
